
Lindenwood has awarded the Girl Scouts of the USA over \$250,000 in scholarships for the upcoming school year to recognize outstanding youth. The three levels of scholarships range from \$5,000 to \$12,400 per year, or \$20,000 to \$49,600 (excluding an earned \$2,400 work and learn allotment) over a four-year period. Please find the attached scholarship information sheet that explains the criteria and application process for each scholarship.

With its main campus in St. Charles, Missouri, Lindenwood is a four-year, co-educational, liberal arts university. Much like the Girl Scouts of the USA, Lindenwood promotes the importance of a value-oriented culture and education for all of its students. These scholarships are available through Lindenwood University

Girl Scout Youth of the Year Scholarship:

One \$12,400 scholarship, plus an additional \$2,400 Work and Learn Award, renewable for four years for completion of undergraduate degree for a total of \$59,200.

Criteria: Candidate must have earned the Girl Scout Gold Award, and submit a letter of recommendation from a Girl Scout staff person or adult leader.

Gold Award Scholarship:

\$6,000 scholarship, plus an additional \$2,400 Work and Learn, renewable for four years for a total of \$33,600.

Criteria: Candidate must have earned the Girl Scout Gold Award.

Ambassador Scholarship:

\$5,500 scholarship, plus an additional \$2,400 Work and Learn Award, renewable for four years, for a total of \$31,600.

Criteria: Candidate must be a registered Girl Scout through her graduation year of high school.

The candidate must:

Criteria:

- a) have been involved with the Girl Scouts of the USA
- b) meet University admissions requirements
- c) apply as (and remain continuously enrolled) a full-time semester, undergraduate residential student in good academic and social standing
- d) be a new undergraduate resident, freshman or transfer student for the upcoming academic year, not previously contacted by Lindenwood University
- e) complete a financial aid application or provide necessary information to assess eligibility for federal and/or state grants. Any additional outside grants and scholarships will first replace the Lindenwood University scholarship. Any additional institutional aid must be approved by the Dean of Admissions
- f) all scholarships are subject to space availability. Candidates need apply early.
- g) Those interested in the \$12,400 scholarship must apply as soon as possible
